

# Clinical Residencies

Innovative teacher preparation at the next level



At The Educators College, we take your skills and your passion to the next level. Our education program is unlike anything in the country. It is dynamic and blends the components of instructional knowledge, clinical experiences, and deep subject matter expertise with leadership development. When you graduate, you'll have a master's degree and be ready on day one to change the lives of children—so you can help them discover what they're made of.

## 1 Evidence-Based Content with Embedded and Intentional Field Experiences

Our clinical residency is the culmination of 4 years of intensive coursework and clinical field experiences that are specifically designed to not only build capacity with our future educators but to also ensure that our residents are ready to co-teach with a master teacher on day one of their residency.

## 2 Cultural Competency Continuum and Summer Intensive

The cultural competency continuum is comprised of four critical service learning experiences, a master's level culturally responsive pedagogy course and a community based summer intensive all with the purpose of ensuring that our clinical residents have the rich, diverse experiences necessary to be prepared to teach in a variety of contexts, not just the one in which they were raised.

## 3 Partnership and Funding

School partners will invest \$30,000 per clinical resident, which will not only provide an additional faculty member to their school site, but also provide professional development and tuition remission to identified master teachers in the building. The financial contribution from partner schools will support clinical residents in their fifth year.

## 4 Master Teachers

Unlike traditional student teaching mentor teachers, our master teachers

will be identified through a selective process utilizing the same evaluation instrument as is utilized with our residents. Master teachers will receive professional development on co-teaching and instructional coaching as well as tuition remission for coursework through The Educators College.

## 5 Fifth Year Clinical Residency

With the school partner contribution of \$30,000, the fifth year of clinical residency will be FREE for future educators in this program. Not only will our future educators be graduating with their master's degree before they begin their careers, but they will be doing so without the burden of enormous college loans. The students will also receive a \$10,000 stipend to use during that residency year. Another benefit, the residents will be working in a co-teaching collaboration with their master teacher who will be trained to provide formative and frequent feedback in addition to the feedback they receive from our own clinical faculty.

## 6 Induction Support

The Educators College wants to ensure the success of our graduates by offering induction support to our former residents for two years post-residency. If one of our graduates shows the need for growth in a particular skill or competency, then we will be there to offer coaching and professional development to ensure that they improve to better serve the students of our community.
